Blue Sky Wind Farm and Mid-County Wind Farm Environmental Screening Reports – Notices of Commencement and Open House Event

Dear Mr. Allen,

On behalf of AIM PowerGen Corporation, enclosed in the present package is the Notice of Commencement for the Blue Sky Wind Farm and the Notice of Commencement for the Mid-County Wind Farm.

The Blue Sky Wind Farm is a wind energy project that will have a maximum capacity of 50 MW. The Mid-County Wind Farm is a wind energy project that will have a maximum capacity of 30 MW. Both projects are located in the Essex County.

All wind turbines are to be located on privately-owned agricultural land and the affected land will continue to be used for this purpose, in conjunction with the wind farms.

The ESR documents, one for each project, will be prepared and structured to address both the requirements of Regulation 116/01 of the Province of Ontario's *Environmental Assessment Act*, the *Canadian Environmental Act*, and abides by the municipal and county provisions for wind turbines.

Your input on these projects is appreciated and we welcome your presence at the Open House that will be held on Tuesday March 24, 2009, from 5:00 to 8:00 pm, at the Canadian Transportation Museum in Kingsville.
