



About the Federal Environmental Assessment

- The *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act* (CEAA) assessment process is overseen by the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency.
- CEAA assessment applies to projects where the federal government has decision-making authority such as issuing a permit or approval, providing funding, or allocating federal land.
- AIM will pursue funding for the project under the ecoENERGY for Renewable Power Program.
- Planning for the Plateau Wind Project addresses CEAA's guiding principles:
 - Achieving sustainable development through high-quality environmental assessment.
 - Integrating environmental factors into the planning and decision-making process.
 - Anticipating and preventing degradation of environmental quality.
 - Undertaking stakeholder participation.
- AIM is fulfilling the requirements of both federal and provincial environmental assessments concurrently.
