



Overview of the Land Use Planning Process

- In addition to the Environmental Screening Process (ESP), AIM will also require land use planning approvals under the *Planning Act*.
- The ESP and the formal planning process are established by different Provincial Statutes and have different functions.
- AIM will continue to work with Municipal (Grey Highlands and Melancthon) staff throughout the ESP and Municipal Planning Process. AIM will incorporate the policies stated in the Municipality of Grey Highlands Local Official Plan Amendment # 10.
- AIM's planning application will include public notification and public meetings to discuss the Project.
- AIM's planning application will be accompanied by such things as the Environmental Screening Report, visual impact assessment, environmental noise impact assessment, and a shadow flicker analysis.
